## **Mesa Corporation Launches Barcode Scanning Feature**

*New technology to decrease document preparation time*

**Lincoln, Neb. – June 12, 2006** — Mesa Corporation, an industry leader in document and information management, announces the launch of a new Scanning Workstation feature specifically designed for barcode users. The new offering, ‘Grouping,’ allows a user to scan a group of documents and identify the group by the bar code value on the first document. This technology eliminates the need to have barcodes on each document within a group. Without grouping, scanning workstation requires users to apply a barcode to each document.

Grouping involves the use of a bar-coded separator page that places related documents into specific sets or groups. Each document following the bar-coded page will be ‘grouped’ with the bar-coded page until Scanning Workstation detects a new bar-code. When the new bar-coded page is detected, a new group is established. For example, medical laboratories receive requisitions – on which the requisition number is the bar-coded value. Accompanying documents may include a physician’s order to run a test or an ABN (Advance Beneficiary Notice). In either case, with Grouping in use, the supporting documents will automatically be assigned the bar-coded value from the requisition.

“This barcode technology will give users the ease and convenience they deserve when scanning,” said Tom Manning, president and CEO of Mesa Corporation. “The benefits are numerous, with the most outstanding being the overall decrease in document preparation time. Imagine the time saved if a group contains 100 documents and a user needs only to place one barcode on the first page of the group instead of placing a barcode on each document.”

Instead of first creating a barcode sticker for every document to be scanned and then placing each sticker in a specified area on each document, ‘Grouping’ allows the user to create only a single barcode for an entire set of documents on which the same bar-coded value is to be attributed.
